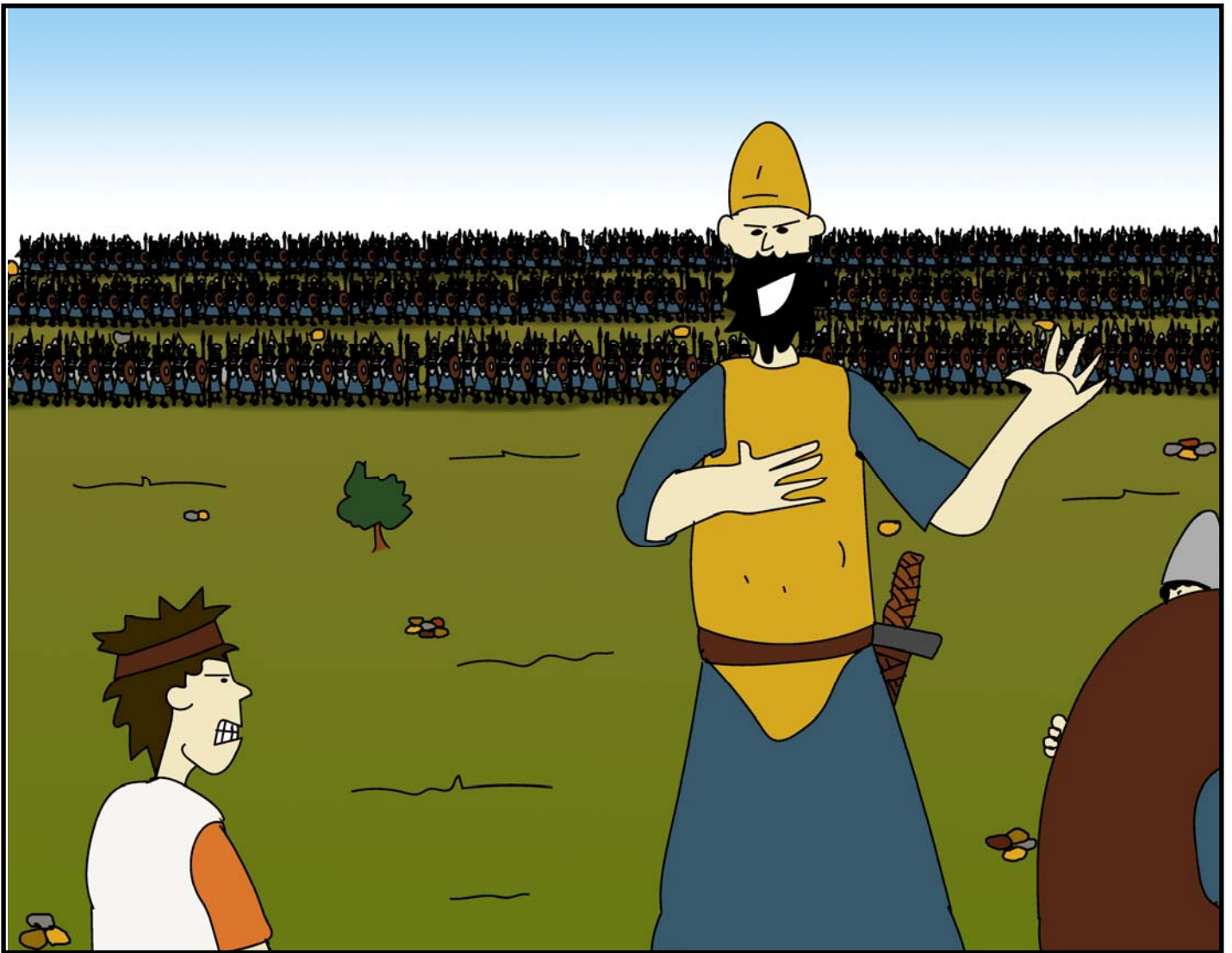

- ♦ Defeats Goliath with a single stone
 - ♦ Handsome young boy
- ♦ Philistine warrior
- ♦ Keeps a shield bearer in front of him
- ♦ Proclaimed the Lord's name while facing Goliath
 - ♦ Defends the army of God
 - ♦ Defiles the army of God
 - ♦ Curses David

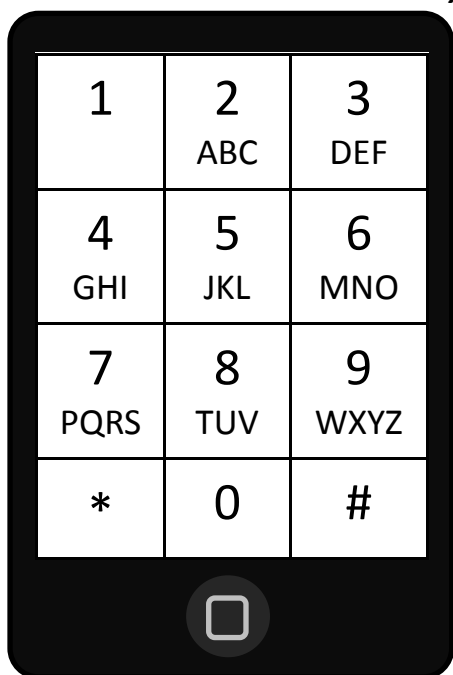
Would you rather be more like David or Goliath?

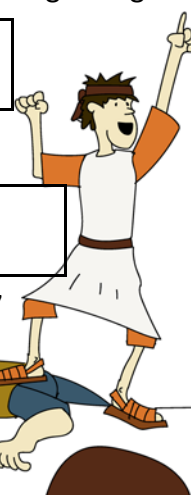
