




Sunday: Jesus Enters Jerusalem


When crowds gathered to see Jesus enter Jerusalem they were expecting to see a powerful and royal king.

Monday: Jesus Clears the Temple


Jesus went to the temple and he didn't like what he saw.

Jesus said, "My house will be called a


but you are making it a 'den of robbers'." Matthew 21: 13 (NIV)

Friday: Jesus On Trial



Matthew 27:27-31 tells us what the soldiers did to Jesus:




They put a staff in his right hand and knelt in front

They **spit** on him and **beat** him. THE JEWS








Friday: Jesus is Crucified

At noon, darkness fell on the land. It lasted for three hours.


Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." Luke 23:46




Sunday: The Resurrection
